Holy Rosary Family Faith Formation  
April 3, 2018

The catechism states: "In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ, and therefore *the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained.*" By the power of the Holy Spirit, the *substance* of the bread and wine are changed into Jesus. Thankfully, the appearances, or *accidents* of the bread and wine remain. This is called *transubstantiation*. As I teach the children: "looks like bread and wine, smells like bread and wine, tastes like bread and wine. Is it bread and wine? NO!" The entire Jesus is contained in both *species*, the bread and the wine. The host contains Jesus' body, blood, soul, and divinity. The chalice contains Jesus' body, blood, soul, and divinity. And even the smallest particle or droplet of the Eucharist is Jesus, whole and entire.

Jesus foretold His presence in the Eucharist in the gospel of John: "Those who eat My flesh and drink My blood have eternal life, and I will raise them up on the last day." And St. Paul states: "For all who eat and drink without discerning the body eat and drink judgment against themselves." (1Cor 11) The church has always believed that the Eucharist is really Jesus.

In prayer, especially as we go to Holy Communion, let us meditate on this real, physical and spiritual presence of Jesus dwelling in us. How can it be that our God has willed for us to receive such a gift? How does this union of Jesus with me change who I am? Am I allowing the Eucharist to empower me to live a life of love?
