Family Faith Formation

*Come join in the LITURGICAL CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS!*

Who: The Blessed Trinity, the entire people of God, including the Blessed Virgin Mary, the angels and saints, and all the baptized. Bishops, priests, and deacons, as ordained ministers, acting in the person of Christ. Lay ministers participating as servers, readers, choir, etc. All the faithful engaging in active participation.

What: Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation, Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, Matrimony, Holy Orders, Mass, Liturgy of the Hours, solemn blessings.

When: Most solemnly in the Easter Triduum, every Sunday and holy day, on feast days, daily Mass, in the celebration of every sacrament, in the Liturgy of the Hours, throughout the liturgical year.

Where: Wherever the faithful gather, they are the “temple of the Living God,” the living stones built into a spiritual house. Church buildings “signify and make present” this spiritual reality, and so are the house of God. Christ our High Priest constantly celebrates liturgy in Heaven.

How: Through physical signs and symbols, words and actions, with God’s word, in prayer and in song, and sacred images.

Why: To give praise and worship of God, to make present Christ’s saving work, to communicate God’s life and love to His people.
