

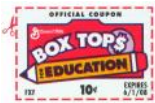

### Family Faith Formation

Did you see your children's crosses they made last Friday in Family Groups? Look inside the cross to find the ways the children "take up their crosses" and become joyful disciples!

Today the students in grades 3-5 had the opportunity to celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation, and the 6<sup>th</sup> grade did so at their retreat last week. Congratulations to them on their personal encounter with our Lord and His great love! Our next "Confession Day" will be December 14.

The "Celebration of the Christian Mystery" is the title for the second part of the Catechism. In it we learn about the mass and sacraments of the church. We start with the idea of **liturgy**, which means the "participation of the people of God in the work of God." Let's think about that: What is the work of God? The salvation of the world. And He lets us participate in that. Amazing.

It is important to remember is that God is not constrained by time. The **paschal mystery**, the suffering, death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus, was indeed an historical event that happened once and for all. But it is part of the divine eternity and transcends all times. Jesus established the church to communicate, or *disperse* His work of salvation through its liturgy. In the mass and sacraments, God the Father pours His blessings into us through the Holy Spirit, who makes Jesus present in the priest, the word, the people, and uniquely in the Eucharist. We in turn bless the Father by our response of adoration, praise, and thanksgiving. We present to the Father the offering of ourselves. We enter into the paschal mystery, and our sacrifice of praise becomes one with the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. We are in communion with each other, united in the life and mission of Christ.

A priest once asked me how many masses I had been to in my life. I sensed a trick question, so I paused to consider. The answer is ONE! The liturgy, especially the mass, is one and the same paschal mystery made present to us each time we celebrate it. We don't repeat it, we enter it. We allow it to transform us into the image of Christ, to bear fruit for the church and the world.
