The teachers created the plans and had students practice this learning.

The plan for this week will be to have all students attend school on Monday, March 16th. Once again, if parents are uncomfortable with this, the students' absence will be excused. On Monday, we will have the teachers and students practice and finalize everything necessary to ensure continued at-home learning. Teachers have plans for taking attendance while students are learning from home. We will have teachers checking in with students daily. On Wednesday, we will begin distance learning. The distance learning will continue for Thursday and Friday. Currently, we are planning to have students return on March 30th after spring break. We will re-evaluate the constantly changing situation closer to that time to determine the best ways to keep our Holy Rosary Families safe. Please continue to pray for healing and guidance during this difficult time.
