Approval of Minutes: Sandy and Amanda approved the minutes of the last PTO meeting of November 10.

Principal's report: Carina Van Pelt reported

- Coming events
 - St. Nicolas Day Celebration for the students on December 7th. Tina Moyer helped Sandy Hartenstein organizing this event. Each child made paper shoes and got a Prayer Card, St. Nicolas Sticker, and candy.
 - K-6th will be going to the Museum of Idaho from 12/9 to 12/10. Each class will get the entire museum to themselves
 - Herman Phillips, the oldest alumni of Holy Rosary School celebrated his 93rd birthday.
 - The Second Grade will be performing the Advent Skit, Jesse Tree, on 12/9 from 12:30 to 1:00. It will be live streamed on the school's Facebook page.
 - Barnes & Noble Book fair: Online and In-Store. **In-Store:** all day 12/9 and 12/16. **On-Line:** 12/9 thru 12/14 and 12/16 thru 12/21.
- Third grade is quarantined secondary to positive Covid tests. It was suggested to quarantine before and after travel but to let the teachers know.
- Registration for next year will begin in January for current students. Cost is \$75.00. February 1st, registration is open to public.
- Will probably continue ½ Fridays for rest of the school year. This helps teachers prepare and meet the needs of the students.
- It has not been decided yet if enrollment will be limited for next year or if students, staff, and volunteers must have the Covid vaccine.

Treasure's Report:

- The corrected October budget is \$72,026.81. The December budget value is not available yet.

Restaurant Fundraiser/Box Tops Report:

- Receipts for Box Tops are \$247.30 for this year since July.

OLD BUSINESS: Wine Auction Update

- Income: \$72,573.20 (includes \$15,615 Call to Heart)
- Expenses: \$8,561.08
- Profit: \$64,012.90
- Future discussion concerning going Virtual again and including a non alcoholic option for the VIP box

OLD BUSINESS

- Fund raisers:
 - Krispy Kreme - \$12.00 a doz giving a \$6.00 profit. \$1000.00 minimum order required for free delivery. Must order at least 1 week ahead. Suggest doing the fund raiser on February 12th for Valentines Day. Will promote two weeks ahead.
 - Motor-Vu Drive In – No fee, no minimum number or attendees, 10% of profit. We would no have to man the snack bar. Discussed waiting until spring.
 - Papa Murphy’s and Pizza Hut– 25% of profit.
 - Little Gym – “Play Dates”. \$10.00 per child. Will give 50% back to school.
 - School Store – This is like Amazon Prime. A certain amount of each sale goes back to the school. Sandy will get more information
 - Dutch Brother’s and Starbucks Drive Thru – have not gotten back to school Sandy. Jean volunteered to take over.
- Yearbook: The contract has been set in as well as the cover design. Four students helped design the cover. Suggested Price is \$12.00 per yearbook. An account can be set up on line and payment can be made thru Bell or thru the school. Orders can be made starting the second week in January and over the next month. Sponsors are needed if the plan is to make the yearbooks available to everyone including those who can not afford to buy one

NEW BUSINESS

- Carina will conduct a Facebook survey as to the benefit of continuing reminder stickers for school events.
- Carnival will not be held in the traditional manner on 1/22/2021. Discussed having a Carnival type day in P.E. where the students can play some of the Carnival games and win prizes (no sugar). Sandy and Magali will work on this plan.
