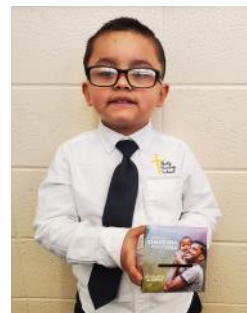
Rice Bowls for Lent

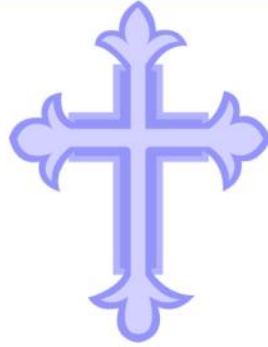
