- II. School Board Ambassador Discussion (Hollie)

- IV. Principal's Report-**1<sup>st</sup> case of covid in the school. Carina is putting in the Panther Pause what happens/quarantine guidelines when in close contact/direct contact (indoors less than 6 ft for more than 15minutes) with a person diagnosed with Covid:**
  - i. If not vaccinated then a 14-day quarantine.
  - ii. If vaccinated then can still come to school and monitor symptoms. Individual must be masked the entire time.
  - iii. Secondary exposures do not require the above.
  - iv. Currently no plan described for if you have had covid/covid antibodies so would follow plan for unvaccinated described above. Carina is open to discussing a plan for this if anyone finds information that says differently.  
-Currently we are in crisis standards of care; Bonneville County is in the red with last week 42.1 transmission rate. We have had kids quarantined from other exposures outside the school.

**-Carina is encouraging everyone to read panther pause.**

**-Still growing enrollment and we have a new pre-k student.**
