Sick Sense



1. It's not too late to get the flu shot. The flu season lasts from November until May. Earlier is better so you can build up immunity.
2. The symptoms you should call your doctor are: body aches, fever and extreme exhaustion. They are rare for a cold, and you can be prescribed an antiviral medication. These make aches and pains less severe and shorten suffering by a day if taken within 48 hours of symptoms.
3. How long should a person stay out of school or work? You should be symptom free - fever, diarrhea or vomiting for 24 hours.
4. The best way for dodging flue germs: Soap and water or alcohol based hand sanitizer. Soap and water are tops for removing the virus from hands. A sanitizer with 60-95% alcohol can kill up to 99.9% of flu germs.
