**Principal's report:** Carina Van Pelt reported

- Through school board and staff discussions, it was decided that the treat policy would be changed. Formerly, due to Covid, parents were asked to not bring in treats for birthdays, etc. The new policy allows families to send in treats as long as they are individually packaged. So, in addition to store bought, the treats must be individually packaged.
- All current students will receive the placement guarantee form today for the 2012-2011 school year. All students registered by 1/27/21 will be guaranteed a spot at Holy Rosary for the 2021-2022 school year. Enrollment will open to the public on Monday, 2/1/21.
- Catholic School Week is 1/25-1/29/21. There will be a dress-down day and donations will be asked for. The dress-down days will include crazy hair, crazy socks, super hero/sports, and "Sunday Best". The donations can include toiletries, socks and canned goods. Teachers will have the specifics for their classes.
- There is no carnival this year. Magalia Hernandez, the PE teacher, and Sandy Hartenstein have organized to have carnival games played during PE. A goodie bag will be given to each student.
- The Communications Survey indicates that most parents get the information they need from Panther Pause and email communications from the student's teacher. Ambassadors will be utilized to help build relationships with parents and how Holy Rosary can help students be successful. One goal is to help maintain enrollment in the school.
- Panther Pause will continue to be a source of opportunities for parents to get volunteer hours.
- Plans for the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the School in 2022 continue. Events will begin this summer.
