

From the Principal...

Eleven years ago, at the end of July, I became the principal of Holy Rosary Catholic School. On that day, there were 92 students registered for that school year, and I needed to hire a secretary, a cook, and two teachers. Moreover, the school was significantly in debt to the parish.



Over the past eleven years, with the help of this wonderful community and by the grace of God, enrollment grew to 183 students right before COVID. In addition, We have ended every year with a budget surplus, paid off all the debt to the parish, grew the endowment to \$2 million, and even put money into savings. In addition, we have seen academic test scores continually outshine the test scores in the best public and charter schools in our area. Moreover, at Holy Rosary, we have witnessed families join the Catholic faith and students growing closer to God every year.

I am incredibly grateful for the opportunities I have been given at Holy Rosary School, especially the opportunity to grow in my own faith. I am beyond grateful for the support of Bishop Peter, the dioceses, and the priests I have worked with over the past eleven years. I am also very thankful for the wonderful teachers, staff, and families.

I will finish my contract for this year, but will not be coming back next year. I will miss you all and continue to pray for you, your family, and Holy Rosary School.
