Studies have shown that school tardiness and excessive absences have a negative impact on learning outcomes.

“When children are absent from school, they miss out on consistent instruction that is needed to develop basic skills. Children in early grades are particularly susceptible to falling behind in fundamental reading skills, which can have a snowball effect that impacts future learning.” [source](#)

At Holy Rosary, students are marked tardy if they arrive after 8am. The handbook states, “After the third tardy recorded, a parent phone call will be made. After the fifth tardy recorded, further disciplinary action will occur.” Also, per the handbook, “Unauthorized absence from class or school” is an “intermediate offence” subject to disciplinary action.
