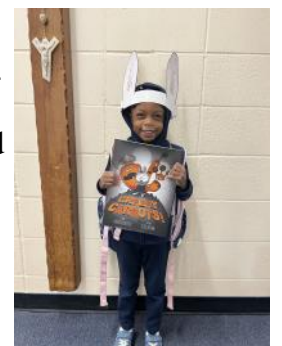


Thanks to **Gene Kantack** and the **Kantack family** for providing fabulous patriotic t-shirts for the students and staff.

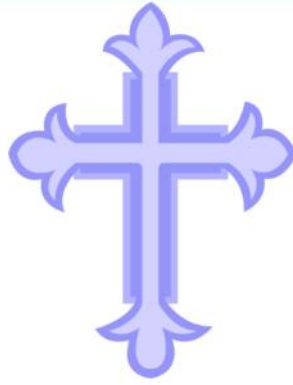
